

Setting up


Slimline wall mount — Magnetic remote holder

- Slide the cover of the wall mount up and slide the rear plate down at the same time.


2 Position the rear plate against the wall and mark the holes.



3 Drill the holes following the drill manufacturer's instructions.




Fix the rear plate to the wall and reattach the cover.




Setting up

Battery installation


- Push the safety latch on the back to
- release the battery cover using a pen or pointed object.



Slide the battery cover to open.




Remove the battery **before** removing the plastic contact tab.




The contact tab may rip if the cover and battery have not been removed first.

Install the battery following the symbols inside the remote. Return the battery cover to close.






Channel 0 is preset to control all blinds paired to your multi-channel remote control.

Add shade to a remote control channel







Setting limits

? Guide to pressing buttons


To avoid damage, practice a quick press and long press when shade is not near the top or bottom.

Quick press is a step motion = 'jogging' mode

Long press is a continuous motion = 'running' mode


Set an upper limit

Press and hold **Up** for 3 to 5 seconds to move shade to the desired highest position.



If using 'running' mode, be prepared to press **Stop** when the shade is 6 inches from the top. Then continue using 'jogging' mode to raise the shade.

2 Press **Stop** when at the desired highest position.



3 Press and hold **Up** and **Stop** for 3 to 5 seconds to save upper limit.



Setting limits


Set a lower limit

Press and hold **Down** for 3 to 5 seconds to move shade to the desired lowest position.



If using 'running' mode, be prepared to press **Stop** when the shade is 12 inches from the bottom. Then continue using 'jogging' mode to lower the shade.

2 Press **Stop** when at the desired lowest position.



3 Press and hold **Down** and **Stop** for 3 to 5 seconds to save lower limit.





Set a favorite position


1 Move shade to the desired position by pressing **Up** or **Down**.



2 Remove battery cover and press **P2**.





3 Press Stop.









Adjusting limits

Adjust the upper limit

1 Hold **Up** and **Stop** for 3 to 5 seconds on the remote control.



- Motor response
- 3 to 5 seconds
- ↑ 2 x jog
 - 1 x long beep
- 2 Move shade to desired position. Hold **Up** and **Stop** to save position.




Adjust the lower limit

1 Hold **Down** and **Stop** for 3 to 5 seconds on the remote control.






- 1 x long beep
- 2 Move shade to desired position. Hold Down and Stop to save position.




Removing shades from channels

Unpair shade from remote control channel







Troubleshooting motor issues

If the motor is not responding

Remote battery is discharged Replace the battery

Battery is inserted incorrectly Check battery polarity

Radio interference Check the remote is not near metal objects

Shade is too far from the remote Operate remote closer to the shade motor

Shade motor battery is low Charge shade motor with micro-USB cable

If the motor doesn't run

Poor electronic connection Check connections

Improper installation Check installation and troubleshoot

If the motor stops during operation

Shade reached lower limit Adjust the lower limit

Improper installation Contact UBlockout customer support

If the remote is not responding

LCD display is black Replace the empty battery

Remove battery contact tab
